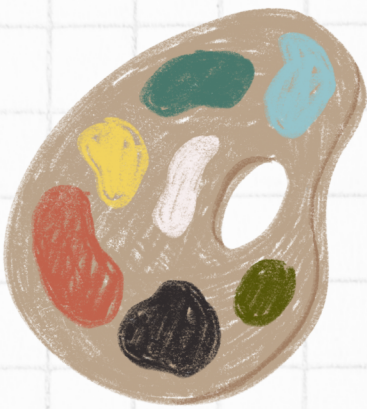

Find new, lightly used craft & arts tools, materials, books etc that you don't want or need, and you would like to donate.

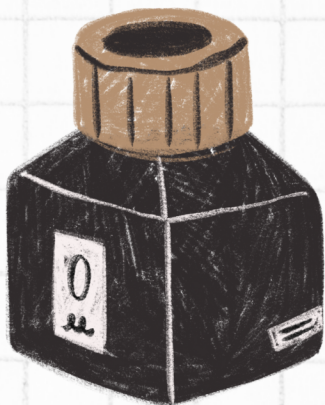

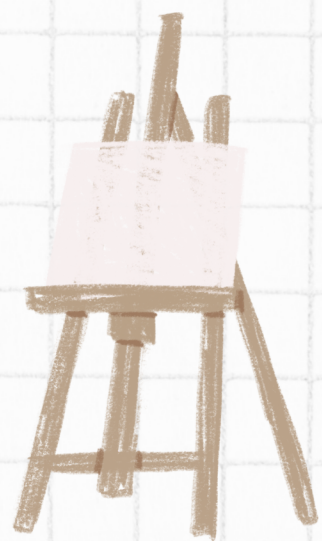

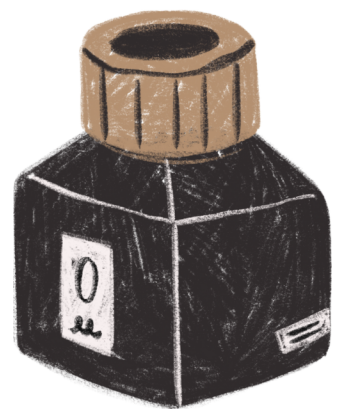

FAQs

What is 'a bundle'?

Bundles is our name for an item (e.g. a book, a sewing machine), or group of items (e.g. a selection of beads, a set of magazines).

A bundle is not based on size or value, rather an instinctive, negotiated assessment that feels a fair & appropriate exchange for a spending token.

Bring things you don't use, don't want and are happy to donate.



How many bundles can I bring?

There is no limit to what you can bring. Just make sure it can fit into the boot of a car.

What happens if I can't drop off on the day?

Not a problem! Pick up can be arranged during the week of the 14th August in return for a small fee to cover fuel costs. Early drop off can also be arranged. Please contact jay@makingplace.co.uk

What if I don't have any bundles to bring?

Not a problem! Come along anyway and see what you'd like to have in return for a donation. We would like to see everything rehomed if possible!

I'm decluttering, and don't want to spend any tokens. Can I just donate my items instead?

Yes of course! You are welcome to donate your items.

We will happily accept gently used, quality items that you no longer want or need and hope to inspire others to make and create.

What happens if I don't see anything I want, or don't spend all of my tokens?

We hope that everyone that wants something will find at least one new-to-them item.

This is our first Crafty Bundles event - we hope that lots of people will get involved and that there will be lots of choice.

However, if you don't see anything you want or like you will be able to save your tokens for the next event.



Will someone be available to help me unload?

Our volunteers will be on hand to help wherever possible.

Will I make any money from my swaps?

No, we are encouraging people to pass on what they don't want or need as a donation. Any income generated will help cover costs of putting on the event.

I've changed my mind! Can I have my swaps back?

Unfortunately, once you've dropped off your swaps we will be unable to return them as we won't be keeping track of who gave what. You will be able to come to the swap and reclaim your item if it's still available though.
